Networking Apericena Venue

An Apericena is something in the middle between an Italian aperitif (aperitivo) and a sort of dinner (cena). The Apericena will be held in an historical palace 5 minutes walking from the Cathedral (Duomo), in palazzo Budini Gattai.

It will be an informal and private event that each participant will pay in advance **36 €** per person and it is open also to accompanying persons. The cost includes catering and logistic support.

Accomodation

Attendants can look for the best option for them and your accompanying people on the widely known booking platforms. We warmly recommend booking in advance to find the best solution according to your needs or preferences.

Please, consider that Firenze can be expensive and that early September is still the high season (in Firenze there is not a real low season!), so we encourage all attending members to book their accommodation asap, especially if they travel with accompanying family and/or friends.

Transports



Firenze Airport “Amerigo Vespucci” <https://www.aeroporto.firenze.it/en/> and city centre are very well connected by taxi (fixed fare 22 € + 1 per luggage in case your destination is in the city centre) or by a tramway, direct from the airport to Santa Maria Novella (SNM) train station. Santa Maria Novella (<https://goo.gl/maps/6mUDW65oxf31L3gy9>) is the central station of Firenze and it is inside the old city centre, 10 minutes walking from the Cathedral (Duomo); info about tickets here <https://www.gestramvia.it/tickets/?lang=en>
Firenze is also easily connected to **Pisa airport** <https://www.pisa-airport.com/en/> and **Bologna airport** <https://www.bologna-airport.it/en/>, both by bus or train to SMN station. Most of the low-cost flight companies land in Pisa and Bologna airport and not in Firenze.



Taxi

Taxis can be found in specific parking spots located throughout the city (train stations, Piazza Duomo, Piazza Repubblica, Piazzale Michelangelo, and many other spots all over the city centre), and it can also be requested or booked by phone, text/chat message, Apps. To call a taxi visit <https://4242.it/en/> or <http://www.4390.it/en/>. Usually, in Firenze, people do not stop a taxi by waving hands on the street, so do not be surprised if the taxi does not stop! BUS

Autolinee Toscane is the municipal bus company. Tickets can be found at bars/tabacchi and other authorized resellers. It's also possible to buy them via text message (not all operators). Tickets purchased ahead of time cost 1.50 euro, the ones via text message 1.80 euro (+ cost of the text message). They all last 90 minutes from the time of validation



Tramway

The ticket is the same one as the bus. It can be purchased at the ticket machines (there is one at every stop), from the same sellers of the bus tickets, via text message and online. It cannot be bought onboard. The tramway system connects the city centre (stops at the Santa Maria Novella train station) with the airport, main hospitals and other neighbourhoods. It does not operate in the city centre.
