

#### 1. Just visiting and watching


The address of our wiki site is <a href="https://forestrestorationwiki.org/">https://forestrestorationwiki.org/</a>

Once you get there, you will see following screen:




By typing of term of your interest in the search field in the upper left side of the page, you can search available pages.

By scrolling down, you will see all pages available:




In PEN-CAFORR COST Action (CA19128) we are aiming to translate ForestRestorationPage to as many languages as we can with native language speakers review and revisions. Yet, if your native language is not on the list of translated pages (blue frame on the figure bellow), you can use the machine

translator by click and choosing your language in the language menu (red frame on the figure bellow).




#### 2. Creating account

On the upper right side of the (any) page click on the <u>Create account</u> link. It will bring you to the following page:



After filling the requested data, click on the "Create your account" button and you will create your account and a personal page, like this:



After this, you can do much more! For example, you can:

- 1. Create the new page (MOSTLY APPRICIATED!!!)
- 2. Edit existing page!
- 3. Discuss the content of the existing page.
- 4. Translate the existing page to your native, or any other language.

#### 3. Create the new page

First, check does the page that you want to contribute to already exist, by looking at the bottom of the Main Page:



If it exists, go to the "Edit existing page" section of this instruction. If it does not exist, you can easily create it by replacing "Main\_Page" the name of the new page in the address line of your browser, like on following two figures:




When you are typing the name of the new page, you can leave the empty space between words as the (\_) sign will be added automatically to the address. This action will automatically create the draft page.




You can finally create the new page by clicking at one of the two links framed in red at the above figure.


You will be taken to the following page:



I suggest you to "Switch to the visual editor" as it does not require knowledge of the script for editing the pages. This tool is installed to help to the ForestRestorationWiki contributors. You will get the instruction on how to proceed.



By typing some text below the page title and by clicking the "Save page..." button at the upper right corner, you will create the page.




You can fully edit page at this point, but you can also save it and continue working it at any time. For how to edit the existing page, see the next section of this instruction.

## 4. Edit existing page!

At the page that you want to edit, click to the "Edit" button.




The visual editor will be open, giving you the opportunity to see the changes that you made as they will be visible to the reader.



As you can see, the interface is simple and thanks to the "Undo" function, you can explore all tools available and tailor the content as you like.

#### 5. Discuss the content of the existing page

At the page that you are interested in to discuss, click the "Discussion" button in the upper left corner.



On pages without any previous discussion, you need to create the discussion page.




You can do it by simple adding the text and by clicking the "Save page" button.




The new page will be created.



# 6. Translate the existing page to your native, or any other language

After logging in to your account, on the page that you are visiting, click on the "Translate this page" link (red frame on the below figure).




#### You will get the following page:



In the upper right corner (red frame) select the language that you want to translate the page on.


You will be taken to the following page:




By clicking at the section of the page that you want to translate, the following window will open:



The easiest wat to edit sections with links, web addresses and pictures is to click on the "Paste source text" button.



Then you can replace the parts of the text that needs to be translated by retyping it or by using copy and paste functions in one for the machine translation tools (Google translator for example).



Once you have your text translated, click on the "Publish translation" button, and it will automatically take you to the next section. Once when all sections are finished, the page is fully translated. However, you can still stop working at translation and continue at any time. The level of how much content of the page is translated will be indicated next to the language name.



Once when the whole page is translated, the four green squares will be shown, like it is with the other languages at this example.
